

**MINUTES**  
**CITY OF VICTOR REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
**August 12, 2010 – 7:00 P.M**

- I. **CONVENE REGULAR MEETING/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** The meeting was called to order by Mayor Buck Hakes who led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Appoint Budget Officer for 2011 Budget – (brought by)Sandy Honeycutt:** A motion to appoint Nancy Hanks budget officer for the 2011 budget session was made by Veldean Petri and seconded by Diana Bowman. RESOLUTION #2010-08-12.01 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SOUTHERN TELLER COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT MILL LEVY BALLOT QUESTION AND URGING ALL CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF VICTOR TO VOTE IN FAVOR THEREOF (Item brought by Tim Braun):** After a presentation by Tim Braun and Candy Shoemaker, Mr. Braun encouraged the support of the increase mill levy question by way of the resolution. A motion to adopt RESOLUTION #2010-08-12.01 was made by Don Daniel and seconded by Michael Wallace. Roll call vote: Diana Bowman, yes; Don Daniel, yes, Veldean Petri, yes; Michael Wallace, yes; Buck Hakes, yes. Motion carried.
- D. Victor City Flag – Nancy Hanks/Veldean Petri:** After Veldean Petri made a short presentation regarding the lack of a City Flag, and her support of a contest to develop the artwork for the City Flag, Diana Bowman offered to donate \$100 of her stipend to a prize pot for the contest. This was followed by Veldean Petri, Buck Hakes, Michael Wallace and Don Daniel all offering to donate \$50.00. It was then suggested that the City contribute \$300 to the cause, bringing the total prize package to \$600. Veldean Petri motioned that \$600 be allocated to the winner of the Victor City Flag Contest, that the contest entries must be in to City Hall by 9/30/10, and that the winning entry be announced at the October 14, 2010, Council meeting.
