

Victor Board of Appeals

The City of Victor is calling for volunteers to sit on the new Building Department's Board of Appeals. The primary function of the Board of Appeals is to mediate unresolved building code issues that may arise between property owners/building contractors and the building official. The board is composed of three members **preferably** with some experience in the construction or design trade (contractor, electrician, plumber, mechanical, engineer or architect). Victor residency is not required. Must be willing to execute unbiased professional opinions. The boards' duties are strictly governed under the 2012 International Building Code and City Ordinance #485. The board does not meet regularly, only when mediation is required. Board members are appointed by the City Council and serve the city for four year overlapping terms.
