- A. Smith Heliport rehabilitation in the amount of \$50,000 was seconded by Michelle Wirtz. All were in favor and the motioned carried.

CDBG GRANT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT #1 STREET & DRAINAGE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING AWARD \$95,000: A motion by Terry Akins to approve the CDBG grant agreement amendment #1 for the street and drainage supplemental funding award in the amount of \$95,000 was seconded by Bruce Davis. All were in favor and the motion carried.
