

**MINUTES  
CITY OF VICTOR  
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 4, 2022 – 6:00 P.M.**

- I. **CONVENE SPECIAL MEETING:** Mayor Brandon Gray called the special meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- II. **ROLL CALL:** Present were Mayor Brandon Gray, Councilors Buck Hakes, Mark Gregory, Barbara Manning and Connie Dodrill. Also present was Glori Thurston. Absent was Clark Eastin, City Clerk/Treasurer.
- III. **NEW BUSINESS**
- A. **EXECUTIVE SESSION to determine position relative to matters that may be subject to negotiations, develop a strategy for negotiations, and/or instruct negotiators, pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-6-402(4)(e), concerning the terms of job offer for the position of City Administrator:** A motion by Councilor Manning to go into executive session to determine position relative to matters that may be subject to negotiations, develop a strategy for negotiations, and/or instruct negotiators, pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-6-402(4)(e), concerning the terms of job offer for the position of City Administrator was seconded by Councilor Dodrill. All were in favor and the motion carried.

Mary Bielz, property owner in Victor, stated the importance of working together among City Council, City staff and community. A motion by Councilor Manning to approve the employment agreement between the City of Victor and Glori Thurston was seconded by Councilor Gregory. Roll call vote: Councilor Dodrill – yes; Councilor Manning - yes; Councilor Gregory – yes; Mayor Gray – yes. Councilor Hakes recused himself. The motion carried.
