The following items are accepted for FREE at the Clean Sweep Events from El Paso & Teller County residents ONLY – no trash, no business waste:

- ✓ **ELECTRONICS: ANY SIZE TV or COMPUTER MONITOR**, limited to THREE total per household. Computers, CPUs, printers, fax machines, laptops, notebooks, ultra-books, net books, electronic tablets, DVD players, VCRs, radios, stereos, video game consoles, video display devices with viewing screens greater than 4" diagonally. (Cables/cords/wires will only be accepted if they are permanently attached to the device).
- ✓ **MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS**: (limited to SIX [6] pieces total)
- ✓ **TIRES**: passenger and light truck (limit is NINE [9] per vehicle), on or off rim

*(You may bring the following items **along with** any of the items listed above. The items below are also accepted for FREE during year-round routine appointments:)*

- ♻️ **Paint** and paint-related products (stains, strippers, thinners, varnishes, etc.) – **50 gallon limit.**
- ♻️ **Household chemicals** (aerosols, ammonia, bleach, cleaners, lamp oil, etc.) **ALL LIDS AND NOZZLES ON AEROSOLS MUST BE REMOVED AND DISCARDED PRIOR TO DROP OFF.**
- ♻️ **Lawn & garden chemicals** (fertilizers, pesticides, poisons, plant food, etc.)
- ♻️ **Automotive chemicals** waxes, bug / tar / vinyl / chrome / engine cleaners, etc.
- ♻️ **Automotive fluids** - motor oil, antifreeze, brake & transmission fluids (**each limited to 10 gal, must be in containers no larger than 5 gal filled ONLY ¾ full containers must be left at site**)
- ♻️ **Batteries** lead-acid vehicle batteries, lithium ion, NiCad, UPS (must remove housing), and household batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, 9-volt, watch & hearing aid batteries). *No corrosion. Must come in clear bag or jar.*
- ♻️ **Fluorescent lights**: CFL bulbs, up to a total of 100 feet of tubes

**X NOT ACCEPTED:**

- **Appliances** (fridges, microwaves, ovens, etc.)
- **Business Waste** (includes schools, churches, nonprofits, etc.)
- **Large Loads:** *½ pickup bed or more of paint/chemicals will not be accepted at this event. Call for a free routine drop off.*
- **Medications** [visit [takemedsseriously.org](http://takemedsseriously.org)]
- **Trash**
- **Wood / Lumber / Furniture**
- **Yard Waste** (leaves, branches, etc.)
